# Miquel Mont Nunca es suficiente



Miquel Mont was one of the artists who came to Josep Suñol's attention in the early 1990s, when the collector was particularly interested in emerging artists working outside the official art circuits. It didn't take long for Mont's work—with its focus on the analytic side to painting—to join the collection.

In France in the late 1960s, new groups such as BMTP and Supports/Surfaces were defending painting as a medium and material and were simultaneously rejecting narrative figuration, at a time when the dichotomy between figuration and abstraction was a central issue. For Miquel Mont, any conflict that might have arisen from this opposition had all but vanished when abstraction had become a coded language. Nevertheless, almost two decades later, here he was, carrying on the transformation begun by the French groups and putting painting at the very core of his work.

Mont explores the boundaries of painting from a purely formal perspective, and what stands out from his work is the way he treats and uses paint. In his pieces from the 1980s and 1990s he plays with the density of paint and creates almost three-dimensional objects.


His later works—including the selection of pieces on display in this show—expand in surface area and merge with the space. In the pieces in the *Lapsus* series, he decouples painting and medium; geometrical figures with human proportions, made out of industrial materials (plasterboard, MDF, cardboard, etc), are presented alongside similar-sized surfaces painted onto the wall. In these pieces, painting takes on a life of its own and breaks free from its supporting base

to move directly onto the walls in the exhibition spaces. The industrial materials that characterise Mont's work are openly displayed in all their primitive, economical splendour. In the *Coopérations* series, the artist's gesture is at the fore. Paint strokes, affixed pieces of paper and other superposed materials force our attention onto each and every layer in the creative process. Forms devoid of content—Miquel Mont's own words—are what we find in the *Mono-Tones*, constructions that include metal frames, wooden pedestals and black-and-white printed images selected to ensure their content won't steal the show. Finally, the *Collages idéologiques* are packed full of content, but what kind of content? Miquel Mont plays with their ambiguous ideological and material burden and leaves spectators no choice but to become an indispensible part of the work themselves.

The exhibition catalogue includes a previously unpublished conversation between Miquel Mont and Rosa Queralt from 2008, which offers readers a wide-ranging yet highly personal insight into the artist's work. It also includes texts on each of the presented series by Miquel Mont himself as well as pictures from this exhibition.
