FACE (S) presents a selection of works done by the people participating in the workshops of Susoespai as part of the visits to the exhibition *Twenty Faces and Three Crowds* at the Fundació Suñol. The creative process was structured in three work processes that were developed before, during and after visits to the exhibition:

- **DRAWING:** In this first workshop they had to make a face using the technique of drawing, without ever lifting the paper marker.
- **PAINTING:** From the observation of the first works, they created a new face that it added color through the use of paint.
- **COLLAGE:** The last workshop consisted of the incorporation of the collage technique in the creating a third face.

The Susoespai association is a non-profit organization founded in the city of Barcelona in 2009, with the aim of bringing the creation and experience of art closer to people who live together with a mental health disorder. The project seeks to promote the inclusion and socialization of participants, as well as provide stimuli and motivations to help discover their creative potential. The values of Susoespai are focused on the work processes, the individual and collective experiences as a source of learning and skills development that everyone can have.
